

## **Guidelines for Contributors**

The Education India Journal, a quarterly journal on education, provides an avenue for publishing Articles on topics related to different dimensions of Education; Book Reviews; Research Papers, Communications on new ideas, concepts, innovations and recent trends in education, by its practitioners and stakeholders.

Following are the guidelines applicable to contributions:-

Articles submitted for the Journal should be original contributions and should not be under consideration for any other publication at the same time. A declaration is to be made by the author in the covering letter that the paper is original and has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere.

Manuscripts including tables, figures and references should be around 3000-4000 words for articles, 2000 – 5000 words for Research Papers, 1000 words for Book Reviews.

All the papers should be typed in double-space with 12 point font and ample margin on all sides. Name, address and contact details should be there clearly.

The main text should not contain footnotes. References should be given at the end of the paper and should contain only those cited in the text of the paper. The full reference should be listed at the end in alphabetical order running the following style:

### **Books**

Miles, M., & Huberman, M., (1994). *Qualitative Data Analysis*. London : Sage.

### **Articles**

Over, R.(1982). Does research productivity decline with age? *Higher Education* 11: 511-20.

### **Chapter in a Book**

Rendel, M. (1986). How many women academics 1912-1977? In R. Deem(ed.), *Schooling for Women's Work*. London: Routledge.

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The final decision on the acceptance or otherwise of the article rests with the Editorial committee and it depends entirely on its standard and relevance. The article accepted may be modified to meet the journal's standards of contents, presentation and style. Authors may also be requested to revise their manuscripts before they can be accepted for publication. Correspondence in this regard will be done with the first named author unless otherwise indicated.

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Note: All the papers will be sent to the Referees for their suggestions and modifications. You will be intimated for the same if any.
